



THE COLLEGE

Changu Kana Thakur Arts, Commerce and Science College, New Panvel (Autonomous), is a multi-faculty premier institution of higher education with an enrolment of more than 4,000 students and, offers 14 undergraduate, 11 post-graduate and 07 Ph.D. programmes..
